HISTORY:

CRITERIA:

- The nominee must be a member of ADHA.
- The nominee must have a history of regular contributions to their community.
- The nominee must have made a positive impact to those in need through service.

GUIDELINES:

- Nominees shall be submitted to the Awards Committee Chairperson at centraloffice@in-dha.com by February 1 of the year the award is to be given.
- The nominator(s) must submit to the Awards Committee Chairperson a bio that is limited to the nominee's Dental Community Activities, Non-Dental Community Activities and a short essay supporting the nomination, the contributions and outcomes of the nominee's community service.
- This award will be given to one recipient in any given year.
